**Subject: Japans heartbreaking disaster - Supply Chain Concerns**

To Our Customers,

The final impact of this months' earthquake and tsunami on the manufacturers located in Japan is yet to be determined. The Japan earthquake has resulted in the suspension of a significant amount of global production of silicon wafers used to make semiconductors. Azonix Corporation's team is in constant communication with our manufacturer contacts and they are providing as much information as they can at this point in time. The situation changes daily and we are closely monitoring its effect on our ability to deliver Rugged Hazardous Area Computers.

We at Azonix Corporation have completed a commodity analysis of the affected regions and we do not have direct sourcing from Japan. However, we have identified a critical component that we source out of Japan through distribution and we are working through our distribution partners to lock up and bond LCD demands through year end 2011. Azonix Corporation supply chain will continue to monitor and apply risk mitigation strategies to avoid potential delivery impact to our customers.
